Each spring, we award a \$1,500 college scholarship to one high school senior from **each** of the following schools: Bixby, Liberty, Glenpool, Haskell, and Collinsville.

Application Guidelines

All applicants must meet the following criteria for eligibility:

1. Officially enrolled and admitted to an accredited community, two-year, or four-year college.
2. High school cumulative grade point average above 3.0 by the end of the senior high school year.
A copy of the student's transcript must be attached to this application.
3. Applicant should be "well-rounded" which includes being active in school and community activities.
4. Applicant who has not received any other academic college scholarships.

Deadline: Application must be submitted prior to May 1st of the current year. Please email your application, essay, and transcript to the representative for your high school:
